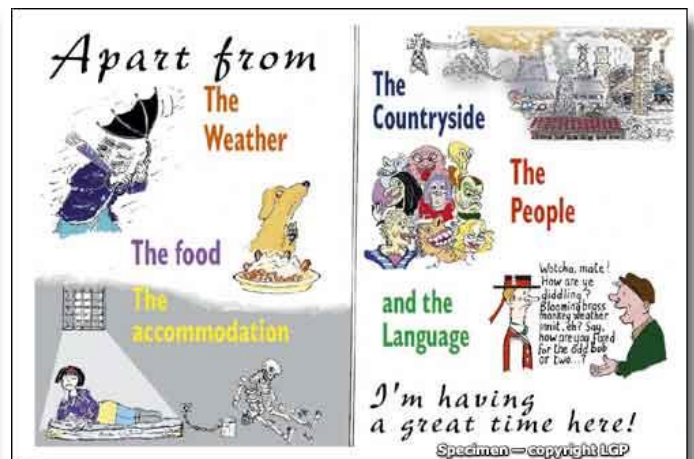
APRIL COMPETITION
